Summary:

This position will be responsible for performing repairs to Port Authority owned equipment and building systems to ensure facilities are clean, organized, safe, and functional.

Reliability, punctuality, and self-motivation with a keen eye for detail is imperative. The ideal candidate will have experience and solid technical knowledge. The candidate must also possess manual dexterity, physical stamina, and be comfortable working from heights and near water.

Duties and Responsibilities:

This position will report directly to the Cleveland-Cuyahoga County Port Authority's Vice President of Facilities and Operations and Industrial Fleet and Operations Manager.

The responsibilities of this position include:

- Inspection: Regularly inspect buildings, grounds, and equipment to identify potential issues.
- Upkeep: Perform duties such as minor painting, landscaping, and snow plowing/removal during the winter
- Maintenance and Repairs: Perform routine maintenance on building systems, vehicles, and power equipment.
- The CCCPA owns and maintains various pieces of equipment including 2 mobile harbor cranes, 2 reach stackers, 1 warehouse overhead crane, 2 manlifts, 1 yard spotter, 1 utility vehicle, and 5 trucks/SUVs. The ideal candidate will possess the ability to learn how these machines function and how to maintain them with the intent of minimizing equipment downtime. A strong understanding of mechanical, electrical, and hydraulic systems is preferred.
